Centre Point Anchor

• In a Default Text Box in Objects and Animation the "Box" will expand vertically and horizontally according to the amount of text which is input

Centre Top Anchor

• Moving the "Centre Point" to the top of the Text Box changes the way in which the text expands



Top Left Corner Anchor

• Moving the "Centre Point" to the top left corner of the Text Box and the Alignment to "Left"

- Note that the Text Box expands Downwards and to the Right of the Anchor Point
- The Alignment is set to LEFT
